RECOMMENDATIONS

Cooperation among the TURKPA member countries in developing cross-border education in a post-pandemic situation to reach the UN Sustainable Development Goal on Quality Education

Bearing in mind that education is essential to the global recovery and the achievement of all Sustainable Development Goals,

Taking into consideration that education is a fundamental right and it is a foundation of resilient, peaceful and sustainable societies,

Noting that education is the basis and a catalyst for the green transition,

Underlining the importance of sustaining and further promoting the progress in education among TURKPA member states,

Being convinced that adequate education represents an indispensable element for the development and harnessing of science, technology and human resources for economic and social progress,

Being deeply concerned about the persistence of the gap between males and females in education,

Underlining the importance of education's accessibility to all people no matter of their physical or material abilities,

Recommends to TURKPA member states:

- to join fully to Bologna Process and integrate European Credit transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) in the future, so the education system of Turkic states can integrate with the advanced and leading educational systems of the Globe;
- to work on reforms in educational system to prevent redundant examination of organizations of higher education and teaching staff;
- to adjust a quality system of experience exchange and training for teachers, so they could transmit the gained experience in their own countries;
- elaborate the sustainable system of distant online education that might solve several issues at the same time, such as accessibility to education for people with the difficulties of movement, greening of environment, support of digital transformation, etc.;
- to make an appropriate conditions and environment for teaching staff so they may fulfil their duties;
- widen up the education capacity of TURKPA region through the TURKUNIB and Orhun Process with the increase of number of members and participants of the process.
